

Pennypacker Country Club Covid-19 Policies and Procedures 2021 Season

For the safety of everyone at Pennypacker Country Club, please stay home if you are symptomatic or have had a close contact/potential exposure to Covid-19.

Social Distancing:

- Members from the same household are not expected to be practicing social distancing with each other.
- Members are asked to observe the recommended 6-foot separation from other non-household members when moving about the grounds, pool deck, and tennis facilities (see tennis policies below).
- 15ft by 15ft spaces will be established in the pool area and picnic grove area and numbered for tracking purposes. These spots will help with social distancing and contact tracing (see registration system below).
- Parents are always responsible for the actions of their children. Parents must be active managers of their children and ensure they understand and respect the safety of others.
- Parents and chaperones of children, not lifeguards and staff, are responsible for ensuring their children's social distance while in the pool and moving around the facility.

Registrations System - PCC will **not** have a reservation system, but for contact tracing purposes, PCC will record the spot where each family spends their day. Once a spot selection has been made families will provide the spot number to a staff member sitting at the pool entrance. Upon leaving the pool area for the day, families will be required to notify the staff member you are leaving, so that spot and area can be cleaned and made available to another family.

Masks - Members are requested to wear facemasks wherever practical when moving around the grounds, pool deck, and tennis facility. Face masks are required inside the snack bar area, barn, and bathrooms.

Check-in front gate – PCC members will check-in as usual when pulling into the swim club at the front gate. Check-in will not require membership cards and will be touch-free. Members will be asked by the gate attendant to put their windows down in the car upon entering. The front gate attendant will operate the check-in by matching your picture in the membership system to the people in the car. Therefore it is important that all members have their pictures uploaded in the system before opening day.

Guest Policy – Guests will tentatively be allowed with one request per family, daily. Anyone in the car upon check-in who is not registered in our system, will be considered a guest. Guests transactions will take place at the front gate and guests will be required to give their name and age for our records upon entering the facility.

Waiver – All members will be required to sign a Waiver of Liability when renewing their application on the membership website.

Entrance and Exit - All members will enter the pool area through the barnyard entrance. A check-in table will be maintained by the gate. Once members have chosen their spot for the

day, they will tell the staff member at the table, so PCC can record where they are sitting (see reservation system above)

Chairs – Adirondack and lounge chairs will be placed in some of the 15ft by 15 ft spots, however are not allowed to be moved for cleaning purposes. Not all spaces will have chairs therefore as in the past we recommend you bring your own chairs. Chair storage will not be available this season.

Umbrellas - Umbrellas will be placed in many of the 15ft by 15 ft spots. Umbrellas are not allowed to be moved for cleaning purposes.

Playground, Basketball, and Gaga pit areas – The playground equipment, basketball court and Gaga pit will be open, however we ask parents to be active managers of their children and ensure they understand and respect the safety of others.

Diving Board – Proper social distancing is required while waiting in line at the diving board.

Pool toys – no pool toys/balls will be provided. Members may bring toys to use in the baby pool and frog pool for themselves only.

Gatherings - PCC ask members to be responsible when gathering in the picnic grove and maintain social distancing for safety purposes and respect the safety of others.

Thunder – To prevent crowding in the barn area, the club will be cleared after thunder and members will be asked to wait in their cars.

Bathroom - Social Distancing and masks are required in bathrooms. Bathrooms will also be periodically closed for cleaning each day.

Pool Occupancy - Currently, there is no evidence that COVID-19 can spread to people through recreational water. PCC will monitor the number of patrons in each pool and will provide adult swims throughout the day.

SANITATION AND DISINFECTING PROCEDURES

Disinfection procedures shall be different for the pool and grounds. Members should continue to protect themselves and others at the facility both in and out of the water by practicing social distancing and good hand hygiene.

Pool Disinfection Procedures – According to the CDC, there is no evidence that the virus that causes COVID-19 can be spread to people through water in pools, hot tubs, spas, or water play areas. Proper operation and maintenance of these facilities (including disinfection with chlorine) should inactivate the virus in water.

- Chlorine levels and other water chemistry limits shall be monitored and adjusted (if required) throughout the day,
- Pool railings, ladders, and other common points of touch will be sprayed with disinfectant at least 4 times per day, a minimum of once every two hours. (A no rinse, spray and walk away disinfectant will be used.)

Grounds Disinfection Procedures – In addition to ensuring water safety and quality, PCC will implement disinfecting procedures for the grounds and facilities. The following common areas and touch points will be disinfected on an hourly basis. Bathrooms may be closed periodically throughout the day for cleaning.

- Door handles inside and outside
- Handrails and pool ladders Restroom doors
- Faucets
- Sinks
- Soap and paper towel dispensers
- Toilet flush levers
- Baby changing stations
- Chairs – Members may bring their own chairs. Limited adirondack and lounge chairs will be available.
- Tables
- Umbrella handles

TENNIS POLICIES

Facilities Rules

- Guests are permitted to participate in tennis programming accompanied by a Member. The Member must greet their guest at the front gate and pre register them on the tennis schedule. The Member must pay guest and program fees prior to entry. No payments will be accepted on the court. An individual guest may use the facility no more than 6 times during the season.
- Members and guests are asked to wear facemasks wherever practical when moving around the tennis facility. They are not required to wear masks while playing.
- PCC asks tennis players to be responsible about gathering in groups and maintain social distancing for safety purposes.
- Members may reserve court times up to 7 days in advance
- PCC will provide a water cooler in the tennis pavilion.

SNACK BAR POLICIES

The intent of the snack bar policies is to minimize potential crowding during the ordering and fulfillment process.

- Masks are required inside the snack bar area unless sitting and dining with your household members.
- Limited dining will be allowed inside the snack bar area (the top of the barn).
- Additional dining will be available outside on the deck, barnyard, and patio areas.
- Tables and chairs are not to be moved for cleaning purposes.
- PCC asks patrons to be responsible about gathering in groups and maintain social distancing for safety purposes.
- Enter the snack bar using the patio door on the left (it will be marked) or the entrance in the back of the barn near the driveway.
- Exit the snack bar using the patio door on the right (it will be marked).
- Social distancing dots will be placed at 6 ft intervals in the line leading up to the ordering counter.
- After ordering, patrons should not congregate, and leave the ordering area immediately.
- Waiting area for orders will be properly marked for appropriate spacing
